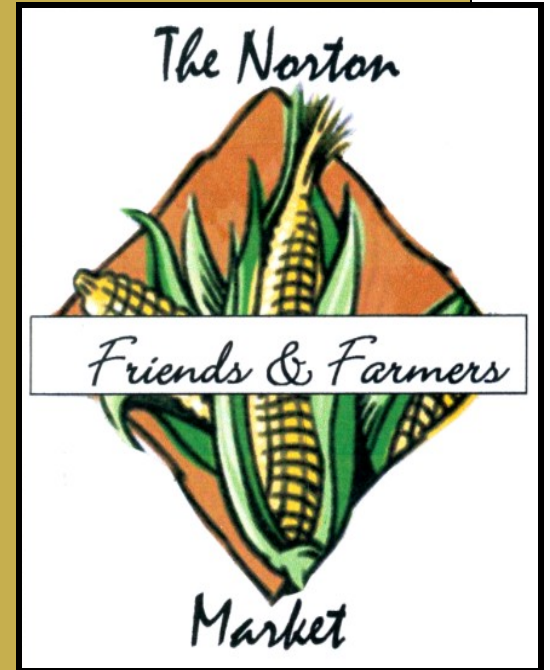

We welcome all local farmers, backyard growers, quality crafters and home bakers! The Norton Friends & Farmers Market is a producer-only market—flea market sales are strictly prohibited. All items sold must be produced by the vendor. The market rules and guidelines can be found at www.nortonfarmersmarket.org/vendors/rules.pdf or by calling 276-679-0754.

It is not necessary to submit an application before vending at the market. Business licensing or permits are not required for vendors conforming to market guidelines. Individual vendors are responsible for any applicable tax obligations and adherence to food preparation/packaging guidelines.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I become a vendor? Contact us by phone, email or regular mail.

Can I just show up and get a spot?

Weekly rental is on a first come first served basis. All vendors must agree to follow the rules of operation. Calling ahead is a good idea, but not necessary. However, non-profits (including churches) should schedule a week before vending.

Can animals be sold at the market? No

Are vendors required to grow, make or bake what they sell? Yes

Are there special requirements for selling ready-to-eat food items? Yes. All ready-to-eat food items, with the exception of baked goods, honey, jams, jellies and molasses must be approved by the market coordinator prior to vending.

What are some volunteer opportunities at the market? We are always looking for musicians, crafters, and other volunteers. Give us a call today and find out how you can participate!
